DESCRIPTION:

The Roamer/Room Leader is a part of most roles within Student Ministry Program. This is the part of ministry that creates relationships, points students to Jesus, initiates conversations, and creates opportunities for life change. This role may happen once your weekly role is filled, or in place of your normal program responsibilities. Here are the goals and responsibilities of this role.

GOALS:

TO KEEP ACCOUNTABILITY AND THE STANDARD OF BIG GROUP GAMES CONSISTENT, HERE ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE ROLE

- Relationships: Student Ministry's goal is always for leaders to build relationships with students. Once a relationship is formed the next goal is to take it deeper. Leaders are expected to be engaged with students and building relationships with them both at the program and throughout the week. Here are some questions to make sure this is always being met: Did you check in with the student you already know? Did you meet someone new tonight? Were there any kids in your environment that you can reach out to throughout the week?
- Leadership: Not all leaders are leading up front, but they all have an important part is creating an environment that respects leadership. As students get distracted, speak out, cause distractions during aspects of the program the room leaders' job is to help keep the distraction to a minimal. Here are some questions: Were any of the students acting out or causing a distraction? Did other students follow the distraction? Were you sitting with students or off to the side? How can we keep better focus next time?
- Invitations: We put on events, retreats, and days away to help students connect with leaders, invite their friends, and make new friends. These events are crucial to our ministry. Each week Roamers/Room Leaders need to be inviting students to the upcoming events. Here are some questions: Do you know all of the upcoming events? Were you inviting students to these events? Did the majority of students sound like they were going? Are you going to the event? Who is one student you can invite throughout the week?
- Conversations: The last goal is all about the importance of conversations with students. Saying hello is important but we want all students to have deeper and more authentic conversations with leaders. This happens before program on lawn. after the program, and if any time presents itself during program. Here are some questions: What conversations were had at program? Any one you need to follow up with throughout the week? Did any conversations give you a chance to pray for a student thought the week?

RESPONSIBILITIES

HERE ARE THE WEEKLY RESPONSIBILITES OF THIS ROLE

- Arrive on campus at least 15 min before Program (6:30-6:45) to engage with students.
- Each week unpredictable circumstances happen, and Program can change on the fly. Please check in with staff for any last minute helps or responsibilities you may need to fill. Flexibility has always been a part of Student Ministry!
- Help keep control of the room during program and help students respect those leading upfront and right next to them
