DESCRIPTION:

The Story Teller's role is to take ownership of knowing and understanding the lesson, the script and making it their own as well as personal. Keep in mind your audience and their ability to comprehend what is being said and how the story relates to their lives.

GOALS:

BE PREPARED AND KNOW THE STORY BEING TOLD

- Read thoroughly: Take time during the week to read through the story and supporting verses. Sit with God and know the meaning and lesson behind the story.
 - Make it personal: If you are not connected to the story the kids won't be either. If you don't understand something you can ask for help or perspective from Children's Director.
 - Creativity: Use the silly voices, fun examples, interact with the kids or have them interact with the story; majority kids are not purely auditorial learners.
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RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Each week reading the Lesson Plan and Story Script with questions and/or concerns already addressed by Sunday morning.
- Arriving 10-15 minutes before gathering you are serving at to make sure classroom is set with all that is needed.
